

Parents and Children: IHS Rules and Responsibilities

Parent Responsibilities – Your child at home

- Importance of notifying the special requirements ie nut allergy and so on to special needs, so that the IHS can do the best for their students.
- Dress code of the students attending the madressa.
- Parent’s involvement in student learning, HW, and punctual attendance.
- Namaz and Qur’an recitation at home
- Children to come with wudhu to classes this term, as it will reduce time for kids to be ready for namaz.

Parent responsibilities – Your child at school – part 1

- Late policy for Classes 1-5: Parents must accompany students to their class and inform the teacher
- Absence – please inform teachers
- Examination rules: If exam taken in 2nd week due to a legitimate reason, then no penalty. If exam taken in 3rd week regardless of reason, maximum cap of 75%.
- Greeting elders, parents, teachers and other students by salam.
- Students to stay back until ziyarat is completed.

Parent responsibilities – Your child at school – part 2

- Bring in children for assembly and namaz
- Car parking etiquettes.
- Parent’s involvement in setup/pack up and cleaning of classrooms.
- Snack rosters.

Parent responsibilities – Your child at school – part 3

- Parents should please stay on the premises for the duration of the madrassah if their child is not capable of using the toilet independently.

- The parents should not call the teachers during the class times for any reason. Phones are on silent. Queries can be asked after class.
- Parents who stay with the children at break time must leave only after a teacher has arrived.

Snack Roster – Saturday 13th May

- We are intending to start with Snack supervision for classes 1-4 by those parents, but will be rolling out more involvement in the coming weeks from all parents.
- Effectively, it will amount to parents on duty ONLY once a term
- Sis Shamim and Sis Nusrat Aga will supervise the running of this for the next couple of weeks and monitor and give feedback on how it's running.
- Being ready near the classrooms straight after namaz in time for Snack, and not leaving the room till hand-over to returning teacher.
- Serving students food and drink in a small supervised manner, clearing up the disposables and rubbish and taking back to the kitchen.
- Vacuuming the room if needed after snack time. This can be changed over the weeks to vacuuming after classes are over as necessary.
- The parents' snack will be provided to them in class with the students' snack so they don't miss out.
